

The Windstorm Mitigation Inspection

A **Windstorm Mitigation Inspection** checks the wind-resistant construction features of your home, and documents the findings. Certain features, if they can be substantiated with documentation or photographic evidence, can lead to discounts on your windstorm insurance.

Your inspector will need to walk around each side of the exterior of your home, access the inside of any attic space (if available), and review any documentation that you may have concerning your current roof, or any opening protection devices you may have.

On the outside of your home, your inspector will determine ...

... whether your roof coverings meet the upgraded building codes.

... what shapes are present on your roof, and the overall roof geometry.
